COURSE DESCRIPTION & OBJECTIVES :

The Career Management Program consists of training sessions that are designed to ensure success at the school, allow the students to formulate a professional project, and develop the student's job search skills. They include interview simulations, access to various computerized HR tests, and the Myers Briggs test. The sessions are facilitated, in part, by HR professionals and recruiters.

The Second Year seminars demonstrate to students how to capitalize on their first professional experience. Students will be asked to reflect on whether that sector of activity attracts them, and why or why not. They will be asked to formulate how they have changed through this first experience. The next internship expectations will be explored. Students will learn how to negotiate more interesting assignments. They will learn how to start building a professional network.
