COURSE DESCRIPTION & OBJECTIVES :

The Career Management Program consists of training sessions that are designed to ensure success at the school, allow the students to formulate a professional project, and develop the student's job search skills. They include interview simulations, access to various computerized HR tests, and the Myers Briggs test. The sessions are facilitated, in part, by HR professionals and recruiters.

The Third Year seminars will explore the feedback from the second internships. The profiles of different jobs and industries will be presented. Students will then plan the strategy for the next internship. Successful role models will be presented – their qualities and their professional strategy. Students will learn how to access the invisible job market through networking. They will also learn how to deal with difficult managers and colleagues. There will also be filmed interview simulations.
