COURSE DESCRIPTION & OBJECTIVES :

The Career Management Program consists of training sessions that are designed to ensure success at the school, allow the students to formulate a professional project, and develop the student's job search skills. They include interview simulations, access to various computerized HR tests, and the Myers Briggs test. The sessions are facilitated, in part, by HR professionals and recruiters.

These Senior Year seminars will prepare the students to enter the workplace after graduation. By this time, each student will have formulated a general career plan. In the senior year, they will refine it. They will also fine-tune their professional networks. There will be interview simulations. Career expectations, generalities and specifics, in various industries will be dealt with. Organizations to enable young graduates to work abroad will be presented. Once again, students will be asked to inventory their strengths and weaknesses and will be asked to perfect their "elevator pitch" for job interviews.
